

# Wisconsin Chapter of the American Society of Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers

## 2011 Scholarship Application for Spring Semester 2012

**Purpose:** In order to promote agricultural appraisal as a profession that is important to the economy and environment in Wisconsin and to advance the science of agriculture in general, the Wisconsin Chapter of the American Society of Farm Managers and Rural Appraisers (WC/ASFMRA) has established a scholarship program for students enrolled in agri-business management, land economics or real estate appraisal.

**Amount of Scholarship:** Up to three \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded for the Spring Semester 2012. (One each to a UW-Madison, UW Platteville and UW River Falls student.)

Deadline for Application: December 1, 2011

Qualifications:

Eligible students must be currently enrolled as a junior or senior and must have an interest in farm management and / or rural real estate appraisal. Majors in agribusiness management, agricultural economics, real estate and production agriculture are encouraged to apply.

This scholarship is based on merit and not on financial need.
